

East Quarter Corner, Section 26, T.134.N., R.31W., 5th P.M.

- 1869 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 20" Norway Pine S10W 90 links.
- 1986 On May 19, Terry Freeman of the Cass County Surveyors Office and backhoe operator Glen Williams dug in the area of the north to south road and where there is a fence to the east. They dug an area 12' north to south by 9' east to west by 3.5' deep. They found 2.5' of gravel-top and fill. Then they dug 1' into natural loam-clay ground.
- 1986 On September 18, Terry Freeman and Norman Morris set a cast iron monument in the centerline of the north to south road in line with a fence to the east.
