


East Quarter Corner, Section 24, T.133N., 31W., 5th, P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 6" Pine S51E 11 links and a 6" Pine S57½W 5 links.
- 1972 Land Surveyor Dean Anderson platted "Castle Addition To Bigwater". This plat shows the above described corner.
- 1987 On August 11, Cass County Survey Technician Terry Freeman found an iron pipe monument 1"x 12" in the centerline of the north to south road. He replaced this with a telespar with a stamped aluminum cap. The telespar monument was 2"x 18" and was placed down 8".
