


Meandering Corner On East Line, Section 12, T.133N., R.32W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees:
6" Pine S50 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 56 links, 7" Pine N16 3/4W 60 links.
- 1985 On October 29, Cass County Survey Technician Terry Freeman found a 2" iron pipe.
- 1987 In January the Comstock and Davis Company used the corner while surveying township roads in Township 133 North, Range 31 West. The position checks for meandering corner.
- 1987 On October 27, Terry Freeman and Norman Morris tied out corner as shown.
