
Northeast Corner of Section 5, Township 134, Range 31, 5th P.M.

Statement of Evidence:

The Northeast Corner of Section 5, Township 134, Range 31, 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota, was set under the Public Land Survey as a post with four bearing trees in 1858. No traces of post or bearing trees now exist.

The County Surveyor's Office was contacted and corner card information was obtained.

In 1993, while surveying the perimeter of Section 5, the area of the northeast corner of Section 5 was searched. A chunk of metal was found near the point of intersection on the curving of the centerline of County Road No. 102. This position fits well with distances measured west and south during the subdivision of Section 5 and is accepted as the position for the northeast corner of Section 5. The chunk of metal was replaced with a 1/2 inch x 4 feet long iron pipe monument was set and capped RLS No. 16097.
