

North Quarter Corner Section 20, Township 135 North, Range 32 West

1866 In October, the US General Land Office field notes, on file in the Secretary of State's Office, show this corner to be marked with a post and the following bearing trees were marked:

Black Pine 10" S 4° W 11 links (7.26')

Black Pine 12" N 8.5° E 10 links (6.6')

1920 E.B.Horst found both Government bearing tree stumps. Set a 2"x24" iron monument . He measured 2708.2' to the Northeast corner of Section 20.

Jack Pine 8" N 70° 15' E 142.9'

Jack Pine 9" S 66° 44' E 140.5'

1986 Comstock & Davis found 2" iron pipe and took the following ties:

Spike in 8" Poplar WNW 56.21'

Spike in 8" J. Pine SW 68.07'

Spike in 8" J. Pine SSE 53.89'

Spike in 8" J. Pine SE 64.19'

2000 In March, the DNR survey crew found 1 3/4" inside diameter iron pipe down 12" in the center line east-west road. Also found the SSE tie of Comstock and Davis. Our measurement to the Northeast Corner Section 20 - N 89° 58' 40" 2711.17' I accepted the found iron pipe as marking the original location of the corner.
