East Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 133, Range 32



Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 133, Range 32 West, 5th Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1858 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were made to two Pine trees.

In 2003, Mr. Bruce Grivna recovered the corner and filed a Certificate of Location. Bearing ties were set to a Twin Oak, a Birch, and an Oak tree.

On June 20, 2006, Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a Telspar monument. One existing bearing tree was recovered and two bearing tree ties were made to burr oaks. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
