
# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

**Statement of Evidence:**

Northeast corner of Section 1, Township 135 North, Range 30 West

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1858 and a wood post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to four aspen trees.

In July of 1903, a township road order shows the monument.

In 1916, Mr. John Curo recovered the roots of the old Government bearing trees and set a 2" by 48" galvanized iron pipe monument with a cap. A bearing tree ties was made to some stones.

In 1921, Mr. E.B. Horst recovered an iron pipe monument at the corner.

In September of 2006, Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a 2" iron pipe monument and made bearing tree ties to a twin burr oak, a triple elm, a burr oak and a wood post. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
