




## SKETCH OF REFERENCE TIES (NOT TO SCALE)

**STATEMENT ON EVIDENCE**

**Closing Northeast Corner of Section 01, Township 144 North, Range 29 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.**

**In 1873**, P.H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, set a wood post in place to mark the location of this corner and established bearing trees as follows: a 8" Black Pine, N26°W 22 links; a 7" Black Pine, N15°E 29 links.

**In 1900**, The U.S. Army Corp of Engineers located various corners around the Leech Lake and Lake Winnibigoshish Reservoirs. Maps indicate that they found this corner. Surveyor was Horace Dunaway. A copy of the map is on file in the Cass County Survey Department.

**Year Unknown**, Soo Line Railroad right of way map #2 from Federal Dam to Cass Lake indicate corner is 1170 feet east of centerline Sta 318+25 and 338 feet north of centerline Sta 300+90. A copy of the map is on file in the Cass County Survey Department.

**In 1961**, R.H. McDonald, U.S. Forest personnel, found remains of original bearing trees as follows: now a Jack Pine stump and windfall, N26°W, 14.52'; now a Jack Pine stub, N15°E, 19.14'. He set a 2"dia. x 5' galvanized wrought iron pipe filled with concrete and capped with a 3" bronze tablet and set two new BTs as follows: an 8" Oak, S14°E 31.45'; a 7" Oak, S42°W 20.67'. Information on file in the U.S.F.S. Cass Lake office T145N R29W Book 1, Pg.2.

**On July 3, 1963**, Peter J. Meyer, U.S.F.S. surveyor filed an affidavit as to location of Government corner in the Cass County office of Register of Deeds.

**On June 18, 1972**, C. Krause, a U.S. Forest Surveyor, found the 1961 BTs and noted that the area was badly burned. He established three new bearing ties as follows: a 17" Norway Pine, S65°E, 200.0'; a 14" Norway Pine, S37°E, 137.2'; a 72" steel post, due South, 2.3'. Information on file in the U.S.F.S. Cass Lake office T145N R29W Book 1, Pg. 2.

**In May 2010**, Paul J. Hennen, surveyor with Kadmas Lee & Jackson finds corner in place and marks three new bearing trees: 12" Red Pine, N79°W 39.75 feet; 10" Red Pine, N3°W 48.90 feet; and an 8" Red Pine, N35°E 43.70 feet.

**On March 29, 2011**, a Northern Engineering & Consulting survey crew found the 1961 2" iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap, up 18". The 2010 three bearing ties were found and a sign post and south BT's were found as shown on the front page of this certificate. On July 1, 2011, they cutoff the brass cap top and 18" of pipe. Installed new 3.5" stamped brass cap. The brass cap set in 1961 is accepted as a perpetuation of the original corner.
