 That I reside at Cass Lake, Minnesota, and am registered as a Land Surveyor under the laws of the State of Minnesota, having Surveyor's Registration Certificate No. 3628.

I further depose and say that on the 27th day of March, 1962, I found the quarter corner of sections 14 - 15 which was evidenced by one bearing tree from the original government survey of 1873.
