



Statement of Evidence

**Meander corner Sections 18 and 19, Township 134 North, Range 29 West, 5th Principal Meridian.**

- July 1912    W.Hoffman, General Land Office (GLO) Surveyor set a 16 x 13 x 9 inch Granite Stone for the original corner and referenced it as follows:  
9" Pine    N 20° W    217 links (143.2 feet)    11" Pine    S 45°30' W    29 links (19.1 feet)  
Said records are on file with the Secretary of State, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).
- Jan. 1926    P.Hale, Civil Engineer and Surveyor, Replat of Pine Beach, on file in the Cass County Recorders Office (CCRO), as Document Number 83653, pictorial indicates Meander Corner in place.
- July 1926    D.Anderson, LS 3091, Auditor's Plat of Pine Beach, on file in the Cass County Recorders Office (CCRO), as Document Number 145347, pictorial indicates "Stone Monument U.S. M.C." in place.
- July 2004    C.Conner, LS 41643, Certificate of Survey, on file in the Brainerd Office of Widseth Smith Nolting, a copy on file in the CCSO, indicates Meander Corner, the distance to this corner appears to be in error.
- April 2005    B.Hippen, technician CCSO, notes on file in the CCSO, found the 1912 SW BT (now dead) and Granite stone, 0.2' above ground, on slope 20 feet more or less from the shore of Gull Lake.
- July 2013    B.Hippen, technician CCSO, records of the CCSO, found the 1912 Granite stone and the 2005 witnesses. The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by CCSO in 2005 is the correct perpetuation of this corner.
