



Statement of Evidence

Northeast corner of Section 6, Township 139 North, Range 27 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

1863 The US General Land Office, in notes of the subdivision of Township 139 North, Range 27 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

4" Maple	N 86° 30' E	4" Maple	S 84° E
4" Maple	S 27° W	24" W. Pine	N 75° W

Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

1936 CCC Washburn Lake field book no. 7, page 22, on file at the DNR office in Brainerd, show personnel from the CCC searched for this corner and failed to find any evidence of its position. They set a 4" Pine stake at 80 chains from the east.

2013 KLJ field crews searched the area and found nothing. This corner was set lost by single proportion between the Northwest corner of section 6 and the Northeast corner of section 5. A 5/8" x 24" rebar with plastic cap stamped "Leas MN 42619" was set to mark the corner position and is witnessed with the ties shown on the front of this certificate. Jarrett Leas, RLS #42619, after analysis of record and survey information accepts this monument as the correct perpetuation of the corner.
