

SKETCH OF REFERENCE TIES NOT TO SCALE




16d duplex nail



Statement of Evidence

Nov.16, 1863 - G.A.Johnson, GLO Deputy Surveyor, in the notes of the survey of the 3rd Guide Meridian between 9th and 10th Parallels, marked a 14" Red Oak for line.

The above record is on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are on file in the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

CCSO Files

Jun.17,2004 - B.Hippen, CCSO technician, records of the CCSO, found the remains of a 30 inch Red Oak and set a 1-1/8 inch outside diameter iron pipe, stamped 16459 in the center of the root crown and made the following witnesses: 10" R. Oak N 14 degrees W 10.04 feet; 12" R. Oak S 72 degrees W 21.92 feet.

Karvako Engineering

Oct. 31, 2013 - Karvako Engineering Survey Crew located the remains of a 30 in Red Oak with the 1 1/8 inch outside diameter iron pipe stamped 16459 in the center of the root crown as stated in the CCSO 6/17/2004 statement. Witnesses were verified. No other trees for witnesses were close by.

This line tree was accepted as the line tree marked in 1863. Measurement to the southeast corner for this Township was 12,597.27 feet. GLO measurement was 190.89 chains (12,598.74 feet) north of the southeast corner for this Township.
