



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**STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE:** Quarter Corner common to Sections 3 and 4 of Township 144 North, Range 26 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian

**1875;** This corner was originally established by Benjamin C. Baldwin his field notes indicate a post was set to mark this corner position which was witnessed by:

Aspen 4" North 66° East, 9 links  
Aspen 6" South 53° West, 54 links

**1929;** USFS 874 form, on file at the USFS office in Cass Lake, MN, indicates that Edward Iverson, Estimator searched for this corner but could not find it nor any B.T.s.

**1953;** Both the USFS 874 form, on file at the USFS office in Cass Lake, MN, and the Resurvey of 1953 notes in USFS notes Book 1 of Township 144 North, Range 26 West, page 43, show that R.W. Fassett, USFS, set 4" treated post 3½' above ground, scribed "¼ SC." Found a 4"x3" stake marked ¼ S4 set a 2"x2" temp. stake beside old stake for ¼ cor. Corner is in an aspen flat and witnessed by:

Birch 6" North 47° West, 13 links with F.S.L.P.  
Aspen 6" North 43° East, 13 links  
Aspen 6" South 37° East, 13 links

**1970;** USFS notes Book 1 of Township 144 North, Range 26 West, page 43, show that Curt Krause, while working for William Okerman, RLS #6807, found the treated post and old stake in place. He proceeded to set a 5 ½" x 5 ½" x 60" long concrete monument 18" above ground, with a 3" diameter brass tablet stamped RLS# 6807 and witnessed by:

Birch 9" North 47° West, 13 links existing FSLP (1953 Tie)  
Aspen Stump 6" North 43° East, 13 links (1953 Tie)  
Aspen Stump 6" South 37° East, 13 links (1953 Tie)  
Oak 5" South 25° East, 38.5' scribed ¼ S3 B.T.  
Oak 7" South 59° West, 49.7' scribed ¼ S4 B.T.  
Aspen 9" North 55° East, 60.7' scribed ¼ S3 B.T.  
Steel Sign Post 72" West, 1.7' with F.S. signs 54-2 & 54-4  
Treated Post 4" South, 1.9' with F.S. sign 54-2

**1971;** Cass County Affidavit of Location filed

**1983;** USFS notes Book 1 of Township 144 North, Range 26 West, page 43, state that G. Robertson and D. Harmon, USFS, found the monument witnessed by:

Oak 5" South 25° East, 38.5' scribed ¼ S3 B.T. (1970 Tie)  
Oak 7" South 59° West, 49.7' scribed ¼ S4 B.T. (1970 Tie)  
Aspen 9" North 55° East, 60.7' scribed ¼ S3 B.T. (1970 Tie)  
Steel Sign Post 72" West, 1.7' with F.S. signs 54-2 & 54-4 (1970 Tie)  
Treated Post 4" South, 1.9' with F.S. sign 54-2 (1970 Tie)

**2010;** A Kadrmas, Lee & Jackson survey crew found a 5 ½" concrete square monument with a 3" Brass Cap stamped RLS# 6807, witnesses found and established as shown on the face of this certificate.

**2012;** Ross Wamre, PLS #45334, after analysis of record and survey information accepts this monument as the correct perpetuation of the corner.
