

Statement of Evidence**East Quarter corner of Section 8, Township 135 North, Range 29 West, 5th Principal Meridian.**

- June 1865 G.B. Wright, GLO Deputy Surveyor in the notes of the subdivision of Township 135 North, Range 29 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:
9" Ash N 89° W 208 links(137.28 feet) 10" Ash N 62° E 245 links(161.70 feet)
The above record is on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).
- July 1939 J.W. Curo, LS 1428, Cass County Surveyor, Survey Record 554, Book D, page 208, on file in the CCHD/SO, states "we set a 2 x 36 inch pipe for the true ¼ corner between Sections 8 and 9 T 135 Rg 29."
- Sept. 1972 D. Anderson, LS 3091, Plat of STONYBROOK, recorded in the Cass County Recorders Office as Document Number 206758 indicates an iron pipe monument.
- Nov. 1986 D. Landecker, LS 17008, Certificate of Survey, file 8545-1, on file in the Pequot Lakes office and a copy on file in CCHD/SO, indicates a monument found at this corner.
- April 2003 P.J. Axness, Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR), file FMA00508.00.00.01, notes state found a 1.5" Galvanized pipe up 4.0 in Alder swamp, 50', more or less, East of Stony Brook. No other good ties available
- Oct. 2007 B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, found a 1.5 inch outside diameter iron pipe, up 5 feet, drove until it is up 3.5 feet, in Alder swamp, 50 feet, more or less, East of Stony Brook. There are no trees nearby.

The recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by the DNR in 2003 is the accepted location of this corner.
