

- On Nov. 22, 2019 the 1929 C.C.C. Metal Location Poster on a 16" Tamarack was recovered along with several post points in the swamp.
- left monument as found; lowered monument; removed monument (explain)
- On May 19, 2020 a 5/8"x4' rebar with stamped aluminum cap was set in place of the recovered wood post. A 4' steel fence post set adjacent.

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE: Quarter Corner common to Sections 14 and 23, Township 145 North, Range 27 West, of the 5th Principal Meridian.

1873; This corner was originally established by P.H. Conger, Deputy Surveyor under contract to the General Land Office (GLO), now the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). These Field notes indicate a wood post was set to mark this corner position, which was witnessed by:

Tamarack,	4",	S10°W,	40 links,	26.40 feet;
Tamarack,	5",	N65°W,	27 links,	17.82 feet:

1929; (Nov.) United States Forest Service (U.S.F.S.), Form 874-9. E. Juntunen, Estimator found a 2" squared scribed stake in the swamp. He placed a Metal Location Poster (MLP) on a 10" Tamarack. Mr. Juntunen believed this to be a genuine GLO Corner. This corner position was witnessed by:

1929, Tamarack, 10", S86°E, 1 chain:

1934; (May) U.S.F.S. Form 874-9. This form state personnel H. A. Brill, Chief of Party, C.C.C., found a wood stake rotten at the ground and an MLP on the west side of a 13" Tamarack, westerly of edge of Jack Pine, stake in swamp. This corner position was witnessed by

1929, Tamarack, 13", S86°E, 1 chain:

1966; (July) USFS Township Field Book 2, page 5. This notes U.S.F.S. personnel S. Morrison & D. Morgan, found the 1929 MLP on the West side of a 12" Tamarack, and found old scribe stake 1 chain West of TAG. They placed a USFS Tag on a Red Pine 11 chains East of corner on woods road.

2011; (Nov.) USFS Township Field Book Notes, page 5. This notes U.S.F.S. personnel R. Main recovered the 1966 Tag on a 20" R. Pine on the east side of a woods road. He GPS'd this location and then searched for corner but found no evidence at this time.

2019; (Nov.) ICDSM Township Field Book, page 22. ICDSM personnel recovered the 1966 Tag on a 22" R. Pine, the 1929 MLP was also recovered on a 16" Tamarack. At 1 chain westerly, a search recovered 2 post points one being a 4" and the other a 3" diameter post in the same hole. A Fast Static geodetic collection was taken at this position and a 2" Tamarack post was set to mark this position.

2020; (May) ICDSM Township Field Book, page 22. ICDSM personnel returned and replaced the 2" Tamarack post with a 5/8" x 4' rebar with a stamped aluminum cap flush with the surface in a Tamarack and Spruce swamp. Witnesses were added as shown on the face of this document.
