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

- 1873 The U.S. General Land Office (GLO) survey notes and plat, on file in the MN Secretary of State's Office, describe this corner as a post, from which ties:  
    Tam Stub 8", S 66° W, 50 links  
    Tam Stub 8", S 8° E, 75 links
- 1940 Layton, Schaitberger, Phelps, use this corner for their survey but did not establish any references.
- 1965 Morrison and Tucker (USFS) find tag on E side of a 12" cedar with old blazes on it. Approximate corner is 1 chain north of tag.
- 2021 March, the DNR Land Survey Unit conducted a search for the corner but did not find any original evidence. The Survey unit found the metal tag on a 14" Cedar on East side of tree, 6' up, tag says approximate corner 1 chain north. A GPS position was obtained 1 chain north of the found tree with tag. This position was found to measure:

2674.281 feet (GLO = 2640.66 ft) from the North Quarter corner Section 20.

2724.051 feet (GLO = 2640 ft) from the East Quarter corner Section 20.

Analysis of the available information led me to accept to observe position as the corner. The tree with tag, along with record distance of 1 chain north, even though "approximate", is the best available evidence to make this corner determination.
